

IS A LAGOTTO RIGHT FOR YOU AND YOUR FAMILY?

A Lagotto often lives well into their teen years and love their people. They are a good watchdog and generally get along quite well with children. They need to be socialized and trained from DAY ONE!!!!

Each Lagotto is different but most can be quite active. As puppies they love to play and be loved. They are quite good swimmers and love the water. They are highly intelligent and aim to please. These dogs are not good for couch potato people.

A Lagotto does not shed and is considered a good pet for people suffering from allergies. They do need regular grooming, ie clipping three to four times per year and it is important to pluck the hair from their ears to avoid infections.

They can live well as a single dog as long as they have their people. They do not like to be left alone for hours on end. They prefer companionship. They stare at you and their eyes look almost human.

A Lagotto needs to be exercised and stimulated. A good walk three to four times per day would make them very happy.

A Lagotto can be quite territorial and it takes time for them to warm up to strangers or strange dogs. They will be quite vocal when someone comes in. Give them time!!!

Most love to dig and they can make your yard and garden look very sad in a short time. A good idea is a nice sandbox in the corner of the yard and teach them where they can dig.
